

## LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH

### PROPOSED CHANGES TO AN EXISTING BUS LANE ON DENMARK HILL

*(NOTE: This notice is about proposals to reduce the length of an existing bus lane on Denmark Hill. There will be no changes to the hours of operation of the bus lane or the hours of operation of the waiting and loading restrictions within and adjacent to the bus lane – Comments/objections may be made. Please see paragraph 6 below.)*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth propose to make the Lambeth (Bus Priority) (Denmark Hill) Traffic Order 202\* under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The general effect of the Order would be to amend the length of the bus lane on Denmark Hill which lies on the south-west side of Denmark Hill so that it starts from a point 62.5 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Champion Park to a point 52 metres south of the south-eastern kerb-line of Coldharbour Lane.
3. The measures described above are necessary to improve bus journey times and the progression of traffic through the Denmark Hill and Champion Park junction.
