PROPOSED ZEBRA PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS IN ROSENDALE ROAD

[NOTE: This Notice is about proposals to provide new zebra pedestrian crossings at 4 locations in Rosendale Road. Comments are invited - see paragraph 5.]

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth proposes, under section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to provide new zebra pedestrian crossings in Rosendale Road (instead of the existing pedestrian refuge islands) at the following locations:-

- (a) outside No. 274 Rosendale Road and Block C Peabody Trust Rosendale Road Estate (by the south-east side of Guernsey Grove);
- (b) outside No. 258 Rosendale Road and adjacent to the side of No. 9 Peabody Cottages (by the south-east side of Hawarden Grove);
- (c) outside No. 27F Peabody Trust Rosendale Road Estate; and
- (d) outside Nos. 265 and 267 Rosendale Road and Rosendale Primary School.

Zig-zag markings, on which vehicles would be banned from stopping at any time, would be placed on the carriageway either side of each crossing.

2. The new pedestrian crossings are necessary as part of a wider traffic scheme (involving the provision of a two-way segregated cycle lane) which is intended to improve facilities for pedestrians and cyclists in Rosendale Road. The overall aims of the scheme are to reduce road danger, boost safe and sustainable transport and improve air quality and the new pedestrian crossings will provide safe crossing points for pedestrians as part of the scheme.
