ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS GLENELG ROAD, KILDORAN ROAD,
LYHAM ROAD AND STRATHLEVEN ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable utility installation works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban all vehicles from entering or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading a vehicle) in:-

- (a) Glenelg Road, between Kildoran Road and No. 13 Glenelg Road (alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Kildoran Road and Strathleven Road and vice versa);
- (b) Kildoran Road between Lyham Road and Strathleven Road (alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Lyham Road, Margate Road and Strathleven Road and vice versa);
- (c) Lyham Road, between Kildoran Road and Mauleverer Road (alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Kildoran Road, Strathleven Road and Mauleverer Road and vice versa);
- (d) Strathleven Road, between Kildoran Road and Mandrell Road (alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Kildoran Road, Lyham Road and Mandrell Road and vice versa).

2. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. The Order would come into force on 10th August 2020 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingences) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
