ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

**TEMPORARY “AT ANY TIME” PARKING, WAITING AND LOADING
RESTRICTIONS HEYBRIDGE AVENUE**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable new gas main connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth subject to the agreement of Transport for London, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from parking and waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle) at any time in that length of Heybridge Avenue which lies between Streatham High Road and Copley Park (both sides of the road).
2. The ban on parking and waiting by vehicles would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. The Order would come into force on 17th February 2020 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 5 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
