ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(2)

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE GRESHAM ROAD AND NO ENTRY ST JOHN'S
CRESCENT**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of Transport for London, HEREBY GIVES NOTICE under section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 that from 17th November 2020 for up to 21 days :-
 - (i) vehicles proceeding in Brixton Road will be banned from entering St John's Crescent (an alternative route will be available for vehicles affected by the "No Entry" via Brixton Road, Villa Road, Wiltshire Road and St John's Crescent);
 - (ii) vehicles will be banned from entering that length of Gresham Road which lies between A23 Brixton Road and the western kerb-line of Wiltshire Road (alternative routes are available for affected vehicles via (i) Brixton Road, Effra Road, Morval Road, Dalberg Road, Dulwich Road, Norwood Road, Half Moon Lane, Herne Hill, Denmark Hill and Coldharbour Lane; and (ii) Wiltshire Road and St John's Crescent).
2. It is necessary for the restrictions to come into force without delay because of a collapsed sewer.
3. The restrictions will be in force by virtue of this notice for up to 21 days or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. If the works cannot be completed during that period, the Council may issue a further notice under section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or make a temporary order under section 14(1) of that Act, so as to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for a further period of time.
