ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – BARRHILL ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works involving the operation of a crane to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, subject to the agreement of Transport for London, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering Barrhill Road.
2. The above road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (i) Streatham Hill, Telford Avenue and Blairderry Road and vice versa; and (ii) Streatham Hill, Ardwell Road and Blairderry Road and vice versa.
4. The Order would come into force on 30th August 2020 and would continue in force for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out on 30th August 2020 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed in that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days and dates up to the maximum period of 2 months.
