ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – BENTON'S RISE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable works involving the operation of a crane to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:-
 - (a) ban vehicles from entering Benton's Rise; and
 - (b) ban parking, waiting by vehicles and the loading or unloading of vehicles on the west side of Benton's Rise, except in the disabled person's parking places.
2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the road closure described in paragraph 1(a) above would be available via Eylewood Road, Elder Road and Norwood Park Road and vice versa.
3. The road closure and the ban on parking, waiting and loading/unloading would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 7th December 2020 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect on 7th, 14th and 21st December 2020 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on those days then the Order may also have effect on a subsequent day or days within the maximum duration of 2 months.
