ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE CLAYLANDS PLACE AND PALFREY PLACE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable UK Power Networks to carry out works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:-

- (a) ban vehicles from entering that length of Claylands Place which lies between Claylands Road and the south-western kerb-line of Ashmole Place (alternative routes would be available for affected vehicles via Claylands Road, Clapham Road and Elias Place and vice versa);
- (b) ban vehicles from entering that length of Palfrey Place which lies between Claylands Road and No. 2 Palfrey Place (alternative routes would be available for affected vehicles via Claylands Road and Trigon Road and vice versa);
- (c) suspend the one-way system in that length of Ashmole Street which lies between Claylands Road and Trigon Road to allow access and egress as far as the works allow it.

2. The bans and suspension would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. The Order would come into force on 27th April 2020 and would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
