**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE AND WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS  
WOODFIELD AVENUE AND DREWSTEAD ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works to be carried out to replace a gas main, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from:-
  - (a) entering and waiting (including waiting while the vehicle is being loaded or unloaded) in that length of Woodfield Avenue which lies between its junction with Drewstead Road and the common boundary of No. 83 Drewstead Road and No. 1 Woodfield Avenue;
  - (b) waiting (including waiting while the vehicle is being loaded or unloaded) in that length of Drewstead Road which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 40 and 42 Drewstead Road and the common boundary of Nos. 56 and 58 Drewstead Road.
2. Alternative routes would be available for vehicles affected by the road closure described in paragraph 1(a) above via Woodfield Avenue, Mount Ephraim Road, De Montfort Road and Drewstead Road and vice versa.
3. The road closure and waiting and loading restrictions would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 9<sup>th</sup> November 2020 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 12 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 9<sup>th</sup> November until 30<sup>th</sup> November 2020 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect on a subsequent day or days within the maximum duration of 12 months.
