**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – BELLEFIELDS ROAD AND STOCKWELL AVENUE**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable development related works involving the operation of a crane to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering:-
  - (a) the length of Bellefields Road which lies between a point 10 metres north-east of Stockwell Avenue and a point 10 metres south-west of that road; and
  - (b) the length of Stockwell Avenue, which lies between a point 10 metres north-west of Bellefields Road and a point 10 metres south-east of that road.
2. Whenever the bans referred to in paragraph 1 above apply, the one-way traffic systems in Bellefields Road and Stockwell Avenue would be suspended to allow access to and egress from properties in those roads, as directed by traffic marshals.
3. Alternative routes are not applicable as Bellefields Road and Stockwell Avenue do not provide through routes for traffic.
4. The road closures would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
5. The Order would come into force on 14<sup>th</sup> November 2020 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect on 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> November 2020 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on those dates then the Order may also have effect on 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2020 or on subsequent days within the maximum duration of 3 months.
