ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – UPPER MARSH

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable railway bridge inspection and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily: -
 - (a) ban vehicles from entering that length of Upper Marsh which lies between the south-western kerb-line of Westminster Bridge Road and a point 70 metres south-west of that kerb-line; and
 - (b) suspend the one-way traffic system in Upper Marsh to allow vehicles to gain access from Royal Street.
2. Alternative routes are available for affected vehicles via (a) Westminster Bridge Road; Lambeth Palace Road and Royal Street; and (b) Westminster Bridge Road; Baylis Road; Waterloo Road; York Road; Addington Street, Westminster Bridge Road, Lambeth Palace Road and Royal Street.
3. The road closure and suspension of the one-way traffic system would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing or covering of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 5th November 2018 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect at night on 5th and 6th November 2018 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time, then the Order may have effect at other times within the maximum period of 1 month.
