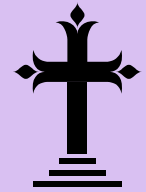


# CHRISTIANITY Key Stage 1

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <b>Christians believe:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ that there is one God;</li> <li>▪ that God loves all people;</li> <li>▪ that God is the creator of all things;</li> <li>▪ that God sent Jesus into the world;</li> <li>▪ that Jesus' birthday is celebrated at Christmas;</li> <li>▪ that Jesus showed people the way to live                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- the story of Zacchaeus;</li> </ul> </li> <li>▪ that God asks Christians to love their neighbours as themselves;</li> <li>▪ that Jesus' death and resurrection are remembered and celebrated at Easter time.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <b>The Bible</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Is the special book for Christians.</li> <li>▪ Teaches Christians about Jesus and God.</li> <li>▪ Contains stories and events from the life of Jesus.</li> <li>▪ Jesus' friends – men and women.</li> <li>▪ Jesus taught using parables.</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ <b>Christians read the Bible and take Jesus as their example</b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <b>Worship</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Christians worship in a church or chapel.</li> <li>▪ Prayer and worship is often led by a priest, pastor or minister.</li> <li>▪ Sunday is often the special day for worship.</li> <li>▪ Everyone is equal and of equal value in the eyes of God</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ <b>Celebrations</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Special celebrations take place in a church, baptisms and naming, harvest, mothering Sunday.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <b>Christian beliefs about God</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ God is Father, Son and Holy Spirit.</li> <li>▪ Jesus is the Son of God.</li> <li>▪ Events in Jesus' life – baptism and temptations.</li> <li>▪ Advent is a time of preparation for Christmas and Epiphany.</li> <li>▪ Lent is a time of preparation for Easter and Pentecost.</li> <li>▪ Jesus' teaching and life give humans the perfect example.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <b>The Bible</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ The source book for Christian belief and teaching</li> <li>▪ A collection of books: the Old Testament concerns all that occurred before Jesus' birth and the New Testament concern's Jesus' life and teaching</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ <b>The Old Testament</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Creation of the world</li> <li>▪ The Ten Commandments</li> <li>▪ Psalms</li> <li>▪ Prophets</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ <b>The New Testament</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Jesus showed His power as a miracle worker</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <b>Belonging to the Christian Community</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Jesus' contemporary followers are world-wide</li> <li>▪ The Church is an international fellowship of Christianity</li> <li>▪ People who have followed the example of Jesus</li> <li>▪ Christians try to show God's love through their actions by loving their neighbours and showing their care for all people</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ <b>Places of Worship</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ There are many different types of Christian places of worship, e.g. churches, chapels, cathedrals.</li> <li>▪ The parish church and an other place of worship</li> <li>▪ The role of the priest and / or minister.</li> <li>▪ Special ceremonies take place there and regular worship and meetings.</li> <li>▪ Prayer and worship are important to Christians</li> <li>▪ Christians read the Bible in church and are recommended to read the Bible daily</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>Places that are important to Christians in the UK and the wider world – what makes them important and what Christians gain from visiting them.</p>
